

Interim Lead Co-Teacher, 2020-2021 Year-Round School Year

Clinton Path Preschool is currently seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Interim Lead Co-Teacher to develop and implement an enriching play-based curriculum designed for a mixed-age (2.9-5 years) cohort of young learners. The

Clinton Path Preschool Board aims to fill this position in Summer 2020 with the potential to transition the position into a permanent placement no later than Summer 2021.

Responsibilities include collaborating with teaching team to to provide a safe and nurturing environment that honors each student as a unique learner, designing curriculum that fits within a play-based model for mixed-age learners, assessing each student's development and growth, preparing progress reports and holding parent/teacher conferences with families throughout the year, planning and presenting displays designed to exhibit students' work for the school community, building upon the school's Extended Day Program to meet evolving needs of the school community, and keeping parents informed of happenings and plans related to the curriculum.

Some additional responsibilities include supporting CPP's community-centered culture by nurturing a welcoming school climate, exhibiting professionalism in communication with the CPP community and attending school events such as school-wide meetings, work days and fundraisers (which occur outside of the school day).

The qualified candidate will ideally hold a Bachelor's degree, be EEC Lead Teacher or Teacher certified (or in the process of obtaining certification) and must have prior experience with young children. This candidate will, above all, love preschoolers, demonstrate a respect for each individual child, find joy in being with young people, and be invested in connecting with all of the students. In addition, the candidate will be enthusiastic and educated about learning through play, appreciative of the natural world, patient, reliable, and committed to maintaining a positive, engaging, and safe learning environment for all children.

Clinton Path Preschool established itself in Brookline as a parent-teacher cooperative over 40 years ago and has since remained committed to inspiring joyful learning through friendship and play in a cooperative community. We believe children learn best when they feel safe to explore their surrounding environment and to take risks. We achieve this by maintaining a strong partnership between parents and teachers and by remaining a small school with no more than 18 students per day.
